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

WHO'S KINI



The name **"Kini"** is synonymous with one of the most iconic motorsport families in Austrian history. For over 50 years, the **Kinigadner family** has been deeply rooted in the world of motorcycle racing. The name Kinigadner is one you cannot miss when talking about motorsport.

While sharing multiple national championships within the family, Heinz Kinigadner made himself a legend by winning two **Motocross World Championships** on an Austrian motorcycle. Not only did he dominate the Motocross world, but he also carved a name for himself in rally racing, competing in various events globally, including the grueling **Dakar Rally**.

Today, Heinz remains fully immersed in the sport. Beyond his racing career, he played a key role in shaping **KTM's future**, helping steer the company out of a crisis in the 1990s and contributing significantly to its rise as a global leader in off-road and motorsport. His influence was pivotal in KTM's resurgence, and he continues to be deeply involved in their motorsport programs.



His extensive involvement in the sport has allowed him to build a strong **global network**, and he remains closely connected to **Red Bull** through his long-standing friendship with Dietrich Mateschitz. Together, they co-founded the **Wings for Life foundation**, which supports spinal cord research and organizes numerous charity events.

This collaboration also led to the creation of the **KINI Red Bull** brand, now managed by his daughter Isabell and his son Hannes at the KINI Bike World in Tyrol.

Heinz's passion for motorsport continues to thrive. Among his many ventures, he operates the **KINI Motorpark** near Barcelona in Spain, an expansive 80-hectare facility he affectionately calls the "Disneyland" for motorsport fans. With ambitious plans for the park, he envisions it as a haven where enthusiasts can immerse themselves in the thrill of motorsport. This reflects not only his own passion but also the deep and lasting dedication of his entire family to the sport.



HEINZ KINIGADNER:

MOTORSPORT LEGEND AND PIONEER AT KTM

Heinz Kinigadner, born in 1960 in Uderns, Austria, grew up alongside two brothers in a household where motorsport was more than just a passion it was a way of life. Heinz has two children with his wife Waltraud, Isabell and Hannes. From a young age, the three brothers had an ambitious plan: each brother would become a world champion, but in different classes. Hansi, the eldest, would conquer the 500cc class, Heinz would dominate the 250cc category, and Klaus was destined for the 125cc title. Although they didn't manage to win the world championships together, in 1980 they achieved an incredible feat by winning all four Austrian championship titles: Klaus in the 75cc class, Heinz in both the 125cc and 500cc classes, and Hansi in the 250cc class. For the Kinigadners, nothing was more important than riding dirt bikes.







Heinz quickly made a name for himself, securing several national championships riding for Puch until 1981. However, a missed opportunity to sign with KTM due to delayed negotiations saw him briefly race on a Yamaha in 1982. Despite winning his first MX Grand Prix on the Japanese bike, Heinz regards that season as bittersweet. The reason? As a proud Austrian, he had always dreamed of winning on an Austrian motorcycle. The fact that his first major victory came on a Yamaha, rather than a KTM, left a mark on his otherwise stellar career — not only for him personally, but also for KTM, which missed the chance to capitalize on his talent during that period. His deep connection with KTM came to fruition in 1984 and 1985, when he clinched backto-back 250cc Motocross World Championships, solidifying his status as a motorsport icon. Although he maintained his competitive edge in the years that followed, recurring injuries prevented him from claiming another world title. By 1988, after enduring years of physical strain, he retired from professional motocross.



That same year, Heinz faced a different kind of challenge — his family's bakery business was on the brink of collapse. With 6 million Schillings in debt and no career prospects beyond his skills as a baker, Heinz found himself in dire straits. One of the few remnants of his successful motocross career was his house in Ibiza. In a bid to find a solution, he began studying business newspapers and soon discovered a company that specialized in rescuing failing businesses. Without hesitation, he reached out, marking the beginning of his relationship with Stefan Pierer, a name now synonymous with KTM and the Pierer Group. Thanks to Pierer's intervention, the family bakery was saved and continues to thrive to this day. Although Heinz couldn't afford to pay Pierer's consulting fees at the time, their bond grew as they spent family holidays together in Ibiza, becoming close friends.

In 1990, while the two were in **Ibiza** once again, a call came from **Arnaldo Farioli**, the Italian KTM importer, reporting serious issues with the company's leadership. Heinz sought Pierer's help, and shortly thereafter, Pierer took control of KTM. This moment marked a turning point not only for Heinz, but also for KTM. Heinz could finally live his dream within the company, playing a pivotal role in shaping KTM's strategy and driving its motorsport activities. On the financial side, Heinz acquired shares in KTM, which he later sold during the company's initial public offering in 1995, securing his financial future. Despite his wealth, Heinz's commitment to KTM and the world of motorsport has never waned. Whether through his involvement with KTM or his many other ventures, his passion continues to drive him forward.





FROM MOTOCROSS

WORLD CHAMPION SHIPS

TO RALLY ADVENTURER

Heinz Kinigadner, already a legend in off-road sports with two Motocross World Championship titles, gained even greater fame in the 1990s through his participation in rally racing. While his Motocross titles earned him respect within the sport's circles, the media attention in rally racing was much larger. The spectacular adventures and daring stages of the rally world captivated a broader audience and made Kinigadner an even more well-known figure. Heinz had his first rally experience in 1989 at the **Inca Rally in Peru** — as a replacement rider with no rally experience. Italian KTM importer Arnaldo Farioli urgently needed a rider, and Heinz stepped in at short notice. Despite multiple crashes and losing his rear brake, he was the fastest rider on the mountain stages, until a severe crash nearly cost him his life. "I landed against a rock wall and was in shock," Heinz recalls. "It wasn't until later that I realized how close it had been. I knew then at least for the moment — that I would never race rally again!" But the shock didn't last long.







In the following years, Heinz participated in more rallies, including the Inca Rally in South America, the Tunisia Rally, the Corsica Rally, and the Atlas Rally in Morocco. Although he still approached each race with the same competitive drive, the adventure of rallying began to take center stage. The unique experiences of these rallies were beyond words.



When Heinz first approached KTM with the idea of entering the rally world, the company was initially unsure if he was serious. At that time, KTM had Enduro bikes but no dedicated rally motorcycles. However, as a close friend of Heinz, Stefan Pierer, then CEO of KTM, gave his support to the idea. Pierer, known for his sharp strategic instincts, did not hesitate to back **Heinz's vision**. This decision would prove pivotal for the company, as rally racing would become an increasingly important part of KTM's future. It also laid the foundation for **KTM's transition** into the street segment, where they are now equally successful. The lessons learned in rally competition, particularly in endurance and performance, played a significant role in the development of KTM's street bikes, helping to expand their product range and market presence beyond off-road racing.

The greatest challenge, however, was the **Dakar** Rally. This famous two-week ordeal tested both man and machine. In 1994, KTM assembled a factory team on a tight budget — far from today's standards, but with an immense amount of passion determination. Although and motorcycles frequently broke down, the team learned from every issue, and Heinz's dedication helped drive significant technical improvements. The hardships of those early years paid off in the long run. Over seven Dakar Rally appearances, Heinz won numerous stages, but crashes and mechanical issues prevented him from ever reaching the finish line. Despite these setbacks, rally racing remained a **defining experience** for him. The unforgettable adventures he lived through made every effort and challenge worthwhile.

Heinz Kinigadner and Dietrich Mateschitz – Special friends on a mission with *Wings for Life*

The Kinigadner family has faced numerous tragedies over the years. They lost their mother early, Hansi, the eldest brother, was left wheelchair-bound after a tragic accident in 1984, and in 2003, Heinz's son Hannes suffered a severe spinal injury during a charity motocross event.

For the Kinigadner's, simply accepting these hardships was never an option. After Hannes suffered a severe spinal cord injury, the Wings for Life **Foundation** was co-founded in 2004 by Heinz and Dietrich Mateschitz, the CEO of Red Bull. The foundation's mission has been clear from day one; make spinal cord injuries treatable. Faced with limited treatment created they foundation to support spinal cord research. The ultimate goal: Finding a cure!

The bond within the Kinigadner family has always been exceptionally strong. With flexibility in his professional life, Heinz has been able to provide unwavering support to his son Hannes. He made a solemn promise: "For as long as I live, I will keep fighting for a cure, and I won't ride a motorcycle again until we can both ride together and enjoy it like we once did!". Hannes, equally determined, holds onto a steadfast belief: "I know that the day will come when I will rise from this wheelchair!"

Heinz and Mateschitz eventually met in person at a beauty pageant in Kitzbuehl, where Heinz was serving as a jury member. The two quickly formed a close friendship. At one point, Dietrich even showed interest in acquiring KTM, although this never came to fruition. By the mid-1990s, as **KTM** was producing reliable, high-quality bikes, Mateschitz became an avid motorbike rider himself. Over the years, their bond grew even stronger, and Heinz eventually became the godfather of Dietrich's son Mark.

After Hannes Kinigadner's tragic accident, the idea of establishing the **Kini Red Bull** brand emerged. Before this, a few helmets and clothing items existed, but it wasn't a serious business. The idea behind the brand wasn't profit-driven. From the start, a large portion of the proceeds went to support the **Wings for Life Foundation**. To date, over €3 million have been contributed from the brand's revenues.










KTM KINI - The KTM/Husqvarna/ GasGas Flagship Store in Tirol

Today, Heinz's children, Hannes and Isabell, manage the Kini Red Bull brand from Kini Bike World in Tirol. This 10,000m² flagship store for KTM, Husqvarna, and GasGas offers the full Kini Red Bull collection. It also features a motorcycle shop, an exhibition space, and a museum showcasing bikes from the entire Kinigadner family's careers. Kini Red Bull products are distributed through the KTM network, their own Kini Bike shop, and at various events.







Heinz Kinigadner's KINI Motorpark is one of Europe's premier motorsport complexes. Located just 35 minutes from Barcelona-El Prat Airport, the facility spans over 80 hectares, offering a diverse range of circuits and tracks tailored for all levels — from motorsports professionals to everyday enthusiasts. Heinz, involved since the track's opening in 2004 and a minority shareholder since 2017, took full control of the Motorpark in December 2023, turning it into his vision of a "Disneyland for motorsports".

The KINI Motorpark boasts a 4.2 km asphalt racing circuit, MX tracks, Enduro trails, Flattrack, 4X4 SUV zones and a Trial parcours. It's designed not just for professional training and vehicle testing, but also for individuals and groups seeking exciting recreational experiences. Clients range from individual riders to major brands like McLaren, Aston Martin, AMG, KTM, Volvo, Bentley, Audi, and Cupra, with 200 days each year dedicated to these prestigious manufacturers for testing and events. The combination of high-quality tracks, off-road zones, and event spaces makes it a favorite destination for

everyone, from hobbyists to hardcore enthusiasts. Everybody can enjoy the thrill of the Motorpark! At the heart of the Motorpark is Heinz's personal passion project: the **Off-Road Park**. Funded through the facility's test business, it offers extensive off-road trails and facilities. Heinz's future vision includes launching an **Off-Road Academy** with on-site accommodation, making the park a one-stop destination for adventure and training.

With its unique combination of motorsports, leisure, and business, the KINI Motorpark offers an unforgettable experience for everyone, from casual riders to motorsports professionals.





Through his long and dedicated career in motocross and rally sports, Heinz Kinigadner has earned recognition well beyond the core motorsport scene. His significant commitment to the Wings for Life Foundation and his connection to Red Bull have helped him form a wide circle of friends, including numerous global celebrities. From the MX circuit to the Formula 1 paddock, MotoGP, and even beyond motorsport, Heinz is a well-liked and respected figure.

Naturally, he leverages these connections to promote and advance the Wings for Life Foundation, consistently using his network for good causes. Whether participating in fun events like the Red Bull **Speed Gang** — supported by **Servus TV** — where he races against former Formula 1 and rally drivers in go-karts on ice, or taking on various challenges on the













DEDICATION TO SAFETY

Alongside his extensive charitable efforts, **Heinz Kinigadner** has been a vocal advocate for **improving safety in motorsports**. In his view, first aid protocols in off-road sports remain inadequate, while in disciplines like **MotoGP** and **Formula 1**, trained track personnel and advanced medical equipment for handling severe accidents are readily available.

"The most critical factor at the scene of an accident is **immediate first aid**, yet organizers and helpers often respond completely inappropriately," Heinz explains.

"Instead of stopping the race or even a practice session, they hastily remove the injured rider from the track without realizing the potential consequences. This kind of action can ruin the injured person's life forever."

For Heinz, it is essential to cultivate a better understanding of how to handle these situations correctly. Through his initiative and team, Heinz is in constant communication with organizers around the world to improve infrastructure and, in particular, the immediate care of injured riders.







Heinz has always been committed to **enhancing safety.** He contributed to key regulatory changes, such as reducing fuel capacity in rally motorcycles, as the increased weight made the bikes' suspension systems unreliable. He also pushed for more precise roadbooks in **Dakar rallies.** At world championship events, a well-equipped hospital must be nearby, along with a helicopter landing pad and appropriate emergency contact information. If these conditions are not met, **KTM** refuses to send any of their riders to compete.

In terms of gear, Heinz has played a significant role in improving protective equipment, including airbags, and especially neck protection. Collaborating with BMW, he helped bring the Leatt Neck Brace to the market. Originally developed by a South African doctor for his son, Heinz and BMW conducted rigorous testing to ensure its effectiveness, allowing it to be officially launched in record time. BMW's efforts resulted in the swift adoption of the neck brace across the industry.

Heinz's dedication to safety has only deepened following the **personal tragedies** he has endured. He remains steadfast in his commitment to making this exciting yet dangerous sport as safe as possible. Now in his 60s, Heinz has devoted his entire life to motorsport, and his passion and dedication show no signs of fading.
